





The Group of Twenty (20) is the premier forum for international economic corporations. It plays an important role in shifting and strengthening global architecture and governance on all major international economic issues. India holds the presidency of G20 from 1ST December 2022 to 13 November 2023.

<u>1999 - Inception of G20</u>: The G20 was founded in 1999 after the Asian financial crisis as a forum for the Financial Ministers and Central Bank Governors to discuss global economic and financial issues.

2008 -Elevation to Leader's Level: The G20 was upgraded to the level of Heads of State Government in the wake of the global economic and financial crisis of 2007, and in 2009, was designated to "premiere forum international economic cooperation.

The G20 Summit is held annually, under the leadership of a rotating Presidency. The G20 initially forecast largely on broad macroeconomic issues, but it had since expanded its agenda to Interalia include joint sustainable development

The G20 presidency is responsible for bringing together the G20 agenda in consultation with other members and in response to developments in the global economy

G 20 members:

The Group of Twenty (G 20) comprises 19 countries(Argentina, Australia, Brazil Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, United Kingdom, Turkey and United States and the European Union. The G20 members represent around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the global trade, and about two-third of the world population.


place in patriarchy society. Moreover, there is also a lack of female education. Women, mostly in rural areas are still denied education for being a female.






From School to College
