Sub : Matter relating to direct recruitment, promotion as well as
placement of Assistant Professor/ Librarian in Selection Grade and Senior
Grade scale of pay in provincialized Colleges.

Ref : Notification No.5(2)H.12/2003/Pt-II/113, dated 15th November, 2010

Sir,

In inviting reference to our Notification No.B(2)H.12/2003/Pt-II/113 dated 15th November, 2010 wherein the Assam College Employees (Provincialization) Rules were notified, this is to clarify that the Committees constituted under Rule 10(A), (B), (C) of the aforementioned Rules for direct recruitment as well as promotions shall be applicable only in cases where UGC guidelines in respect of any of such situations are silent. Wherever UGC has laid down a particular criteria or format for formation of any such Committee, the Regulations laid down by the UGC shall supersede whatever has been stated in the above Rules.

Accordingly, as per the present Regulations of UGC the Committee for selection of Principal is as follows:

Clause 5.1.6 (UGC Regulation 2010)

1. Chairperson of the Governing Body as Chairperson.
2. Two members of the Governing Body of the college to be nominated by the Chairperson of whom one shall be an expert in academic administration.
3. One nominee of the Vice Chancellor who shall be a Higher Education expert. In case of Colleges notified/declared as minority educational institutions, one nominee of the Chairperson of the College from out of a panel of five names, preferably from minority communities, recommended by the Vice Chancellor of the affiliating university of whom one should be a subject expert.

4. Three experts consisting of the Principal of a college, a Professor and an accomplished educationist not below the rank of a Professor (to be nominated by the Governing Body of the college) out of a panel of six experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the university concerned.
5. An academician representing SC/ST/OBC/Minority/Women/Differently-abled categories. If any of candidates representing these categories is the applicant, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor, if any of the above members of the selection committee do not belong to that category.

At least five members, including two experts, should constitute the quorum.

The Committee for selection of Assistant Professor is as follows:

Clause 5.1.4 (UGC Regulation 2010)

1. Chairperson of the Governing Body of the college or his/her nominee from among the members of the Governing Body to be the Chairperson of the Selection Committee.
2. The Principal of the College.
3. Head of the Department of the concerned subject in the College.
4. Two nominees of the Vice Chancellor of the affiliating University of whom one should be a subject expert. In case of colleges notified/declared as minority educational institutions, two nominees of the Chairperson of the college from out of a panel of five names, preferably from minority communities, recommended by the Vice Chancellor of the affiliating university from the list of experts suggested by the relevant statutory body of the college, of whom one should be a subject expert.
5. Two subject-experts not connected with the college to be nominated by the Chairperson of the governing body of the college out of a panel of five names recommended by the Vice Chancellor from the list of subject experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the

education institutions, two subject experts not connected with the University to be nominated by the Chairperson of the Governing Body of the College out of the panel of five names, preferably from minority communities, recommended by the Vice Chancellor from the list of subject experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the college.

6. An academician representing SC/ST/OBC/Minority/Women/Differently-abled categories, if any of candidates representing these categories is the applicant, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor, if any of the above members of the selection committee do not belong to that category

To constitute the quorum for the meeting, five, of which at least two must be from out of the three subject-experts, shall be present.


The Committee for promotion is as follows :

Clause 6.3.5.2 (UGC Regulation 2010)

1. The Principal of the college.
2. Head of the concerned department from the college.
3. Two subject experts in the concerned subject nominated by the Vice Chancellor from the university panel of experts.

As and when the UGC makes any changes in the above, the same shall be automatically applicable. All other terms and conditions laid down by the UGC for such selection and promotion shall be strictly complied with.


