Rotation of topics in a subject in the Course Curricula to be taught by Teachers.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am to state that it has come to the knowledge of the Govt. that many College teachers used to teach the same topic/course curricula of a department for years together without reviewing the topics to be taught and the same are not allotted to other teachers on rotation basis and it is noted to be not a healthy practice of classroom transaction of faculty for imparting quality education.

It is, therefore, hereby requested to all the Principals of concerned Colleges to look into the matter while allocating the classes to the teachers to see that no teacher is allowed to continue to teach the same topic/course curricula for more than three years continuously.

In this regard, the Head of the Department of concerned Department/Subject is to certify to the effect that "no teacher is allotted to teach any topic/curricula for more than a period of three years or so at a stretch".

A detailed report in this regards should be submitted to the undersigned electronically with a copy to the Principal Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Education Department, for favour of his kind perusal.
