

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Between

Bengali Department, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati And





This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of **June 30, 2019** between Bengali Department, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati as the First party

And

Bengali Department, Radha Govinda Baruah College – as the Second party; herein together referred to as 'the Institutions'.

Pragjyotish College, have its campus at Santipur, Guwahati. It stands high with its virtues of excellence and a humble contribution to the society at large. It offers a unique educational experience that prepares the next generation of global citizens to lead and make a difference in the world. With its talented and motivated student-body and accomplished faculty, Pragjyotish College is a leading educational hub in the North-Eastern region that maintains a particular commitment to exceptional undergraduate and post-graduate instructions and aims to be the best College of the region. The faculty of the Bengali department in this institution is doing its level best to achieve the goal of the College.

And

Radha Govinda Baruah College is a foremost institution offering both Arts and Commerce courses under Gauhati University. The college is well equipped with modern infrastructural facilities and backed by an excellent and dedicated faculty to cater to the needs and aspirations of the students to meet the challenges of the present day competitive world. Apart from academic pursuits, stress is laid on co curricular activities and all round development of the students' personality. The vision of the faculty of Bengali department is to disseminate quality education to the students including those who are underprivileged, so that they may realize their potential and become responsible human beings in society.

Whereas Pragjyotish College has requested Radha Govinda Baruah College to collaborate to achieve its objectives, through various programmes in the Bengali Department for the academic promotion with the following identified but not limited to,

- 1. Faculty Exchange Programme Faculty members of the Bengali Department, Pragjyotish College may take a lecture or a series of lectures at the Bengali Department, Radha Govinda Baruah College as Resource Persons for portions or special topics of a few identified courses in consultation with the Head of the Bengali Department, Pragjyotish College and vice versa, at a mutually convenient timing, during the session.
- 2. Students' Exchange Programme Honors students of the Bengali Department, Pragjyotish College may visit to attend lecture, talk, special classes on relevant topics covering the Bengali syllabus, at Radha Govinda Baruah College in consultation with the faculty member of the Bengali Department and vice versa, at a mutually convenient timing during the session.
- 3. Joint organization of Seminar/Symposia/Workshop-Seminars/Symposia/Workshops may be jointly organized by faculty members of the Bengali Department of Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College
- 4. Summer Training Camp/Internship Bengali Department of Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College may recruit students from the department for summer camp

and Internship programme for a period of 4(four) weeks during summer vacation, subject to availability of the faculty member.

This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligation on Radha Govinda Barua College as a partner in this MoU.

Both the Bengali Department of Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this MoU, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clauses below, both the Institutions may attend this MoU by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing Institutions on potential areas.

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the Institutions, that is Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College, shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this MoU. However, Bengali Department of Radha Govinda Baruah College has freedom to continue or discontinue the MoU at its own discretion.

In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoA shall be drawn up as and when required.

The Institutions, that is Pragjyotish College and Radha Govinda Baruah College, agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this MoU shall deem constitute partnership between the signing Institutions appointing one party as an agent of the other. This MoU will be effective upon signature by both the Chief Executive Officers for a period of three years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for further period of three years. Either party may, on three (3) months notice in writing, terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration or request the recognition of its conditions.

The Memorandum of understanding is drawn up and agreed upon to establish cooperation between the Shivaji University hereafter to referred as SUK and the PJCG.

Shivaji University, Kolhapur named after the founder of Maratha Empire Chhatrapati Shivaji and inaugurated in 1962 by Dr. S.Radhakrishnan the then President of India, is a premier institution of higher education and research in western India. The University is committed to meet the educational, social, cultural and economic needs of the region and is dedicated to promote and foster a culture of high quality teaching, learning and research.

Pragjyotish College, Guwahati-Aasam was established on 1st of September 1954. Eminent scholar and litterateur Pandit Tirthanath Sarma was its founder principal. From its modest inception as an Arts college, Pragjyotish College has now developed into its present stature of a famous full-fledged Degree College, imparting higher education in Arts, Science and Commerce streams. The college also has two post graduate departments, viz. Assamese and Tourism Management. It is affiliated to the

Guwahati University and registered under 2(F) and 12 (B) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956. The college has developed its own unique philosophy and vision, mission and programmes of action.

Main Activities of Pragjyotish College:

Pragjyotish College was established with the following Activities:

Every year, the department arranges a special talk regarding various trends of Hindi on the occasion of Hindi Divas. Various competitions are arranged amongst the students to develop reading, writing, speaking and thinking abilities. One educational trip is arranged for the benefit of the students every year. The students of the department take the initiative to publish the departmental wall magazine 'Vageshwari' on an annual basis. Achievements: The department has been showing consistently satisfactory results in the TDC final exams and in one instance even one of the students has secured the First Class First position with distinction. The passout students secure admission in reputed universities like NEHU, Tezpur University, etc. A noteworthy feature of the department is that all the permanent faculty members

of the department are alumni of this department. Organized special lectures By Skype. Invitee: Prof. Padma Patil in 2017-2018.

About Hindi Department:

Year of Establishment: 1960 Courses: Three Year Degree Course: Arts – Major and General Facilities: The department has a reading room, departmental library with a stock of around 520 books, LCD projector and computer with Wi-Fi internet facilities.

Department of Hindi, SUK:

At present Prof. Padma Patil is Head, Department of Hindi, SUK. Two permanent faculty, six contributory and three temporary faculty is working at department. Six Regular Rogrammes are there – i.e. M.A.: Hindi, M.A.: Language Technology, Post Graduate Diploma in Hindi Translation, Post Graduate Diploma in Computer and Indian Language Software application, M.Phil./Ph.D.: Bridge Course and Course Work. Department runs four short term courses with CDAC i.e. i.Certificate course in Hindi Communication ii. Certificate in Indian Language Computing iii. Certificate in Office Automation – Multilingual –GIST: PACE iv. Certificate in INDESIGN-GIST: PACE' and one value added course 'Bharteey open office'.

Departmental Specialization: Hindi Literature, Language Technology, Translation, Comparative Literature, Functional Hindi. Department is developing a database of dialects and also working about development of plagiarism detection tool for Hindi Text. Prof. Padma Patil prepared, directed a short films on some selected literary forms. Department of Hindi has started Skype session with Cdac, Pune from 2017 feb. This is first programme of University level at India.

This academic programme will start from 2018 and it will continue in future on basis of first five years fruitful work by both Universities under MoU. The two parties recognize human resource development and institutional capacity building as the basis of mutually

beneficial co-operative programme, hereinafter referred to as the programme. This memorandum is establishing in year 2018 for five years. Smt. Nandita Rajbonshi; Head, Department of Hindi from PJCG and Prof. Padma Patil from SUK will see the MoU activities.

ARTICLE I : OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The objectives of the programme are to provide opportunities for hindi language, Literature and skill based education related with those for teaching staff members of SUK and PJCG, promote institutional linkage between SUK and PJCG and to explore other avenues for possible purposeful collaboration.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF THE PROGRAMME

The program initially is for five years which plans to provide collaborative cooperation through:

- Collaborative research programs in specific fields of interest SUK and PJCG of Aasaam will jointly identify specific fields to conduct collaborative research programmes of mutual interest and benefit.
- Student exchange programme Exchange programme for SUK and PJCG of Aasaam, students will be explored and conducted accordingly which will be mutually beneficial for both parties.
- Faculty exchange programme Exchange programme for SUK and PJCG of Aasaam faculty will be explored and conducted accordingly which will be mutually beneficial for both parties.
- Interdisciplinary Study: 'Hindi and Aasamiya language', 'Hindi Literature', 'Language Technology', 'Translation technology', 'Hindi Diaspora literature', 'Literature and History' study will obtain assistance from SUK and vice versa for improvement the quality and relevance of above.
- Any other form of co-operation that may be agreed upon between SUK and PJCG.

ARTICLE III: DURATION OF THE PRORAMME

This Memorandum will effective from the date of its signing by both the parties up to a period of next five years. If this MoU is to be terminated without causes, a three months prior notice should be sent by either of the parties as applicable; This MoU may be renewed by mutual consent of both the institutions by written agreement.

ARTICLE IV: SPECIAL: PROVISION

- Both parties shall exchange useful information on each other's educational and training programmes and such other activities.
- Both parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programme.
- Both parties shall exert best effort to be available for mutual consultation and shall be prepared to provide necessary information whenever reasonably requested.
- Any amendment to this Memorandum of Understanding shall be made in writing and mutually agreed upon.
- All disputes arising in connection with the interpretation or application of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual negotiation.
- The two parties will maintain efficient communication in order to ensure effective implementation of the programme.
- This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed by the constructed in accordance with laws of the UNION of INDIA-BHARAT.

Terms of memorandum:

Both the parties agree to carry out the above mentioned activities in accordance with law and regulations of respective Universities and Institution after full consultation and approvals. The parties acknowledge that this Memorandum of Understanding does not

in any way give rise to any right or permission to use or to be associated with each party's intellectual property. Under collaborative research, any patentable research conducted by faculty or student in coordination with other party, sharing of the intellectual property rights will be as per the IP Policy.

Confidentiality:

Each party shall undertake to observe the secrecy of confidential information received from or supplied to the other party during the research activities conducted within the period of implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or agreement made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.

For the purpose of Memorandum of Understanding, "Confidential information" means any information whether prior to or hereinafter disclosed by a party (the receiving party) of this Memorandum of Understanding involving technical, business, marketing, policy, know-how, planning project management and other information, data and/solution in any form.

All information known or received by a party to the other party to this Memorandum of Understanding will be kept asconfidencial and will not be disclosed to any third person.

Settlement of Disputes:

Any difference or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and / or application of any of the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall first be settled amicably through mutual consultation and / or negotiations between the parties. Those which cannot be fully and satisfactorily resolved or settled by the parties shall be referred to the Higher Authorities of both the parties.

Revision, Variation and Amendment:

Either party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this Memorandum of Understanding. Any such revision, variation of amendment agreed to by parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding. Such revision, variation of amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the parties.

Supervening Events:

Each party reserves the right for reason of national security, national interests, public order or public health to suspend temporarily, either in whole in part the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding. The suspension shall take effect immediately after notification has been given to the other party. Any other event which may occur, hinders or restricts the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding, the parties shall use their best endeavor to agree upon such action ,as may be necessary and equitable ,to remove the causes of such event.

The related parties shall be responsible for the expenses for the faculty and the students about collaborative activities under these MoU themselves.

PLAN:

- There will be assistance for teaching Hindi Language, literature, Language technology,translation, comparative studies between and SUK and PJCG by modern digital tools.
- There will be programme for short term courses for regular students.
- There will be plan for research between SUK and PJCG for Hindi Language, literature, Language technology, literature and History, Translation Technology, Comparative studies, Diaspora Literature as interdisciplinary Studies.

• There will be innovative project with the help of C-DAC, Pune i.e. Development of Hindi-Aasmiya language Database (Lexicon or Dictionary) and Localization of website in Aasmiya language through Hindi.

This academic exchange programme will continue in future.

• This memorandum of understanding will be for five years from signing date /year of MoU. Academic activities will be for five years. i.e. From 2018 – 2023.

UNRC-NER and PC have agreed to the following:

1. PURPOSE:

It is the MOU for the cooperating parties to give on the development of the college in the field of Education, Science, Culture and Environment.

2. AREAS OF COOPERATION:

PC has agreed to assist the UNRC-NER of its programme to be executed in the college in the following areas :

UNRC-NER will promote UN programmes to be executed by the PC in the college.

PC will execute the activities/programmes of UNRC-NER while UNRC-NER will support the PC to execute it.

- 3. UNRC-NER will set-up a UN reading library at Pragjyotish College while PC will provide space exclusively for it.
- 4. UNRC-NER will nominate a person from college as a part of delegation for the international conferences if required.
- PC may provide conference hall/training hall to UNRC-NER for its programme jointly.

6. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MOU:

The "Cooperating Parties" shall remit within their respective capacities, mandates and resources, shall make the necessary arrangement to ensure mutually satisfactory implementation of the present MOU.

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

The MOU shall be effective upon signature by both the parties, for a period of 24 months from the date of signature. The MOU may be extended beyond the period upon mutual consent of the parties.

This MOU may be terminated by UNRC-NER or by HPI upon written notice to the other party and shall terminate 30 (thirty) days after receipt of such notice from the parties.

Without prejudice to the foregoing steps shall be taken to ensure that the termination of this MOU will not compromise or discriminate against any of the activities or programme undertaken within the MOU framework.

AMENDMENT:

The MOU may be amended at any time by written agreement of both the parties.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of the MOU or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, which cannot be settled through direct negotiations, will be amicably settled through reconciliation.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of **January 30, 2023** between Bengali Department, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati as the First Party

And

Byatikram Group, Guwahati - as the Second Party; herein together referred to as 'the Institutions'.

Pragiyotish College, have its campus at Santipur, Guwahati. It stands high with its virtues of excellence and a humble contribution to the society at large. It offers a unique educational experience that prepares the next generation of global citizens to lead and make a difference in the world. With its talented and motivated student-body and accomplished faculty, Pragiyotish College is a leading educational hub in the North-Eastern region that maintains a particular commitment to exceptional undergraduate and post-graduate instructions and aims to be the best College of the region. The faculty of the Bengali department in this institution is doing its level best to achieve the goal of the College.

And

Byatikram Group is a foremost institution of Guwahati. The Byatikram Group is 16 year old organization with expertise in various fields like publishing, printing, event management, education services, media and public relations. Byatikram (Meaning 'Exception') is a Bengali monthly magazine published from Guwahati by Vicky Communications & Associates. Brands under Byatikram Group are namely Vicky Publishers, Byatikram MASDO and Byatikram Sanskritik Mancha. The publishing company by name Vicky Publishers, under the Byatikram Group, is a well known publisher of the region and has published more than 700 titles in Assamese, Bengali, English and Hindi. These titles include a good number of translation works too. Byatikram monthly magazine delas with subjects like Career, Poliitics and Current issues, Society, Literature etc.

Whereas Pragjyotish College has requested Byatikram Group to collaborate to achieve its objectives, through a three months DTP program in Bengali as an ADD-on course in the Bengali Department for the academic and job promotion with the following identified but not limited to,

- 1. On job Training Programme After completion of the DTP course the passed out students of Bengali Department Pragjyotish College will be given on-job training in printing or publishing technology for six (06) months by its publishing house. The successful candidates may be given an opportunity for permanent or part-time job in the company.
- 2. **Technical Support Programme** Expertise in the field achieved by the members of the Byatikram Group will be provided during stipulated three months period of the certificate programme, by means of theoretical classes and practical sessions, as scheduled by the coordinator of the programme.
- 3. **Joint organization of Seminar/Symposia/Workshop-**Seminars/Symposia/Workshops may be jointly organized by faculty members of the Bengali Department of Pragjyotish College and Byatikram Group.
- 4. This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligation on Byatikram Group as a partner in this MoU.
- 5. E-certificate to the successful students to be issued by the College authority will bear the brand name of the Byatikram Group and one of the signatories of the certificate will be the CEO of said company.

Both the Bengali Department of Pragjyotish College and Byatikram Group agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this MoU, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clauses below, both the Institutions may attend this MoU by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing Institutions on potential areas.

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of five years. Thereafter, the Institutions, that is Pragjyotish College and Byatikram Group, shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this MoU. Preamble:

Where as History PC is an academic institution imparting Higher Education and Sadichsa is a NGO working towards sustainability and well-being of the society, both have some areas of common interest in shouldering social responsibility. Considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the field of social responsibility.

Now, therefore, History PC and Sadichsa have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter to be referred as MoU) which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two parties set out in the following sections.

Article-I:
