



**Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)**  
**Between**  
**Geology Department, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati**  
**And**  
**Geology Department, Dimoria College, Khetri**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of *20th September*, 2019 between Geology Department, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati as the First party

And

Geology Department, Dimoria College, Khetri — as the Second party; herein together referred to as 'the Institutions'.

Pragjyotish College have its campus at Santipur, Guwahati. It stands high with its virtues of excellence and a humble contribution to the society at large. It offers a unique educational experience that prepares the next generation of global citizens to lead and make a difference in the world. With its talented and motivated student-body and accomplished faculty, Pragjyotish College is a leading educational hub in the North-Eastern region that maintains a particular commitment to exceptional undergraduate and post-graduate instructions and aims to be the best College of the region. The faculty of the Geology Department in this institution is doing its level best to achieve the goal of the College.

And

Dimoria College is a foremost institution offering both Science and Arts courses under Gauhati University. The college is well equipped with modern infrastructural facilities and backed by an excellent and dedicated faculty to cater to the needs and aspirations of the students to meet the challenges of the present day competitive world. Apart from academic pursuits, stress is laid on co curricular activities and all round development of the students' personality. The vision of the faculty of Geology department is to disseminate quality education to the students including those who are underprivileged, so that they may realize their potential and become responsible human beings in society.

Whereas Pragjyotish College has requested Dimoria College to collaborate to achieve its objectives, through various programmes in the Geology Department for the academic promotion with the following identified but not limited to,

1. Faculty Exchange Programme — Faculty members of the Geology Department, Pragjyotish College may take a lecture or a series of lectures at the Geology Department, Dimoria College as Resource Persons for portions or special topics of a few identified courses in consultation with the Head of the Geology Department, Pragjyotish College and vice versa, at a mutually convenient timing, during the session.
2. Joint organization of Seminar/Symposia/Workshop may be jointly organized by faculty members of the Geology Department of Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College.
3. Summer Training Camp/Internship — Geology Department of Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College may recruit students from the department for summer camp and Internship programme for a period of 4(four) weeks during summer vacation, subject to availability of the faculty member.
4. This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligation on Dimoria College as a partner in this MoU.

Both the Geology Department of Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this MoU, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clauses below, both the Institutions may attend this MoU by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing Institutions on potential areas.

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the Institutions, namely Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College, shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this MoU. However, Geology Department of Dimoria College has freedom to continue or discontinue the MoU at its own discretion.


In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoU shall be drawn up as and when required.


The Institutions, that is Pragjyotish College and Dimoria College, agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this MoU shall deem constitute partnership between the signing Institutions appointing one party as an agent of the other. This MoU will be effective upon signature by both the Chief Executive Officers for a period of three years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for further period of three years. Either party may, on three (3) months notice in writing, terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration or request the recognition of its conditions.


