2. **Pragjyotish College**, hereinafter known as PC, a reputed co-educational institution of higher education in Assam, having its address at Santipur, Bharalumukh, Guwahati, Assam – 781009.

DESIRING to cooperate in academic and extra-curricular activities between students and teachers.

PURSUANT TO the prevailing laws and regulations, policies and procedures of both the institutions HAVE REACHED the following understanding:

ARTICLE 1

OBJECTIVE OF COOPERATION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to cooperate in educational endeavors in areas of mutual interest.

ARTICLE 2

SCOPE OF THE UNDERSTANDING

The Parties agree to cooperate on the following points:

- 1. Exchange of best practices.
- Faculty and student exchanges on academic and extra-curricular activities. 2.
- Skill-based courses that are mutually agreed upon by both the Parties. 3.

ARTICLE 3

LOCATIONS OF ACTIVITIES

- The Parties agree to implement the activities stated in Article 2 at BBC and 1. PC.
- Any changes of the location of the programs shall be mutually agreed upon 2. by both the Parties.

ARTICLE 4

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

- 1. Any cooperation under this MoU is subject to the availability of funds, funding sources and approval by relevant authorities.
- 2. Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program specific arrangements.

ARTICLE 5

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE

1. Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between both the Parties.

ARTICLE 6

AMENDMENT

- 1. This MoU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of both the Parties.
- 2. Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by both the Parties.

ARTICLE 7

ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1. This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- 2. This MoU shall remain in force for a period of five years and may be extended by mutual written consent of both the parties.

- 3. Either Party may terminate this MoU at any time by giving prior written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MoU.
- 4. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the completion of any projects and programs in progress.
