Flood relief distributed

GUWAHATI, June 27: As part of its community and outreach activity programmes, various stakeholders of Pragiyotish College, including teachers, retired teachers and students, have contributed in cash or in kind for supplying relief materials to the flood-affected people of Chamuapara village located in Mangaldai Subdivision of Darrang district.

Relief materials like rice, dal, mustard oil, salt, biscuits, packaged milk, mosquito repellent, candles, water bottles, medicines, sanitary napkins, etc. were distributed among over a hundred households in presence of the village headman of Chamuapara, teachers, retired teachers and representatives of the college students' union today.

Adani Foundation also distributed relief materials among 300 families of Bausi village in Hajo today. A team of officials of the LGBI Airport visited the village and distributed foodstuffs and other necessary items, a press release said.

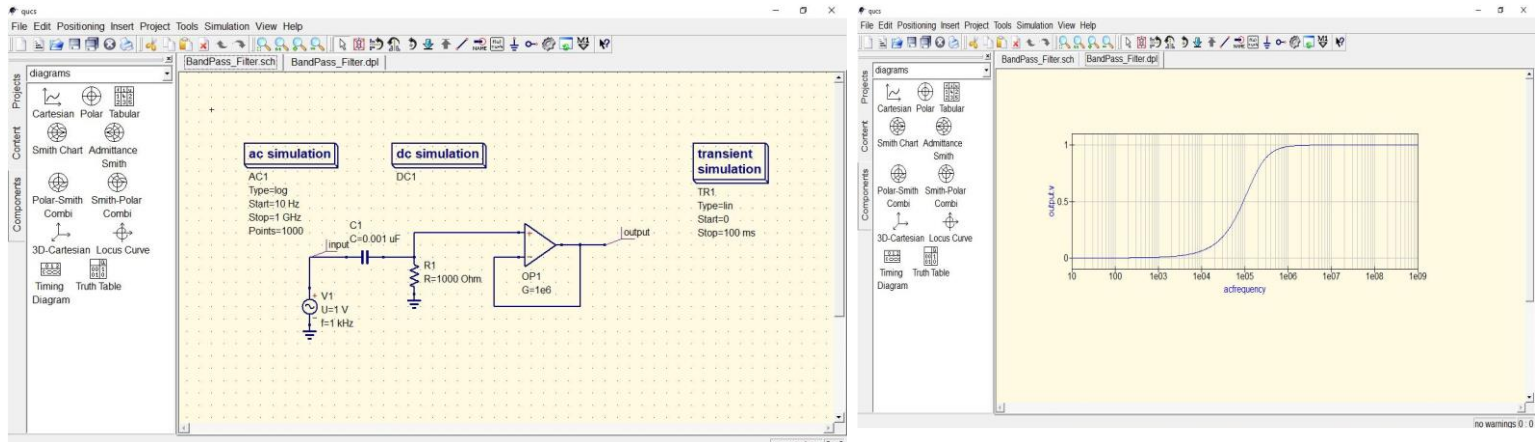
