OBJECTIVE OF THE COURSE: India has a rich heritage of eternal knowledge created, acquired and realized by Indians over several millennia. India is the land of knowledge, because our ancestors considered nothing other than knowledge to be the purest. The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) framework has considered the rich heritage of this ancient and eternal Indian knowledge to be the guiding light in drafting this exhaustive policy document. NEP 2020 has reiterated that "Knowledge of India" will include knowledge from ancient India and an engaging course on Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) in secondary schools (4.27). The role of ancient universities in the context of vibrant multidisciplinary environments, and the need for India to revive such environment in HEIs in creating well-rounded and innovative individuals is also stressed upon (10.2). IKS aims to support and solve various contemporary societal issues in different fields of study. The present course is an attempt to bridge the gap in the vast IKS knowledge domain and create general awareness amongst the targeted learner groups.

COURSE OUTCOME: Students shall gain preliminary knowledge on various core aspects related to the IKS domain.

SCOPE FOR ON-JOB TRAINING FACILITY: There is no present scope for on-job training. However, in future, attempts will be made to adopt experiential learning modes through appropriate tie-ups. Trained learners may also find the course useful in the context of the internship programs and research proposal programs under the IKS Division of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.

TEACHING METHOD: Classes will be held in blended mode, both offline and online. Offline classes will be scheduled during any convenient time slots on working days. Online classes will be scheduled after college hours and on holidays. External experts may be engaged for taking online classes, which will be not more than 10% of the course content.

COURSE OUTLINE:

UNIT 1: INTRODUCTION (5 hours)

Definition of Indian Knowledge System (IKS); Myths about IKS; Importance of ancient knowledge and wisdom; Sources of IKS – literature and oral traditions; Various components of IKS domain; Historical background

UNIT 2: LITERARY WISDOM (5 hours)

Caṅgīdasa-Vidyāsthāna – 4 Vedas (*Rgveda, Yajurveda, Samaveda, Atharvaveda*) and the four divisions of each (*Saṃhitās, Brahmanas, Aranyakas, Upanisads*), 6 Vedāngas (*Vyakarna, Shiksha, Jyotisha, Nirukta, Chanda, Kalpa Sutra*), 4 Upāṅgas (*Puranas, Dharma-sastras, Nyaya and Mimamsa*); 4 Upa-Vedas (*Ayurveda, Dhanurveda, Gandharvaveda, Stāpthyaveda & Arthashastra*); Indian philosophical systems – Vedic systems (*Saṃkhya, Yoga, Nyaya, Vaiśeṣika, Mimamsa, Vedānta*) and Non-Vedic systems (*Carvaka, Jaina, Bauddha*)

UNIT 3: SCIENCE, ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGICAL WISDOM (5 hours)

Historical developments and innovations in the fields of aeronautical engineering, astronomy, mathematics, medicine, mining and metal technology, physics, ship building technology

UNIT 4: ARCHITECTURAL WISDOM (5 hours)

Vastu-sāstra – Town planning, Unitary buildings, Temple architecture; Literary sources

UNIT 5: HEALTH AND WELLNESS WISDOM (5 hours)

Preliminary concept of 5 *pañc tatvas* (*prithvi, jal, akash, agni, vayu*), 7 *dhatus* (*rasa, rakta, mamsa, meda, asthi, majja, sukra*), 3 *tri-dosas* (*vata, pitta, kapha*), 3 *tri-gunas* (*sattva, rajas, tamas*); 5-layered existence (*Panca-kosas*); 4 states of existence (*jagrat, Svapna, susupti, turiya*)

UNIT 6: GOVERNANCE AND ADMINISTRATIVE WISDOM (5 hours)

7 elements of a State (*svamin, amatya, janapada, durga, kosa, danda, mitra*); Significance of *Arthashastra*

EVALUATION PROCESS: A term-end assessment test of 60 minutes duration will be conducted by the Course Coordinator after the completion of the course, where candidates will be required to attempt 30 MCQs in offline mode, each having 1 mark weightage. There will be no negative marking.

CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION: After successful completion of the course and appearing in the term-end assessment test, a Certificate of Participation will be provided to all students, subject to a minimum of 75% class attendance.

REPORT:

1. On the 7th of April 2019, the Information and Career Guidance Cell in association with the department of Hindi had organized a two-day seminar on the initiative of Sahitya Akademi (Hindi Sahasrabharati). The main objective of this seminar was to prepare the students for future employments in the field of Hindi. The seminar was attended by 45 students. The resource had resource persons of good repute. They are Mr. MANU Kumar (former translator IGC) and Mr. Mohan Anand (Secretary, Sahitya Akademi).
2. A pre-orientation camp was organized by the ICGC held on the 9th and 10th of April, 2019 for the students of arts, science and commerce stream in collaboration of the school of banking for the selection of candidates in institutions like IITs and for other purposes like PGDiploma as well as for other professions in Institute / IGC/IBB etc. The participation of students on the first day of the seminar was 50 and on the second day 50/52.
2. A one-day workshop cum seminar was organized by the youth and students of advanced studies (100-101) in collaboration with ICGC on 08/12/2018 to inspire and train the students to take up the civil services. The workshop was basically intended to train the students for civil service examinations. The program was attended by 91 students.
4. A one-day program was organized on 11/11/18, by the Sahasrabharati (Sanskrit) University to motivate students from the economically backward areas to apply for scholarship to pursue UG and PG courses. A total of 18 students had participated in the programme.
5. On the 30th of January, 2019, Shripath University Chennai had conducted a scholarship Entrance examination in association with the Information and Career Guidance Cell/ICGC. The programme was conducted by the coordinator and faculty members of Shripath University. The programme was attended by 54 students.
6. An awareness camp on How to crack SSC, Bank exams etc was organized on 19/01/2019 by the Information and Career Guidance Cell (ICGC) in association with Vision I. The resource persons for the programme were Mr Ravi Shankar Kumar, Director, Vision I and Mr Indran Barman, Faculty, Vision I.

The objectives of the programmes are to prepare the students for future placements. The programme will helpfully guide them and train them to become successful professionals.
