COURSE SUMMARY

TITLE: DTP in BENGALI

COURSE: CERTIFICATE COURSE

DURATION: 3 MONTHS (30 contact hours)

COORDINATOR: 1. DR. JYOTIRMOY SENGUPTA (HOD)

Outcome of the Course:

- Basic Concept: Students will learn to use Bengali Smart and General Key board with Ramdhanu software. The software is easy to install and user friendly. (CO#1)
- Explanation of Concept: Using the software students will easily acquire the knowledge to type not only with Bengali fonts but also with Assamese and Hindi fonts. (CO#2)
- Experimental Use of the Concept: Students can design, prepare projects, write articles instead of hand written manuscripts and make soft copies of the work. (CO#3) They can also able to analyze project documents by developing different artistic ideas. (CO#4)
- <u>Evaluation and New Creation with the Concept:</u> It will enable the students to evaluate their credentials through experiential learning. (CO#5) They will be able to make press copy/ master copy in Bengali, Assamese and Hindi for different journal, magazine, newspaper, authored book etc. (CO#6)

Scope: A MOU has been signed between Bengali Department Pragjyotish College and BYATIKRAM GROUP, Guwahati, in respect of:

- a) Expert assistance
- b) 6 months on-job trainee program for the certificate holders.

After the program candidates may get permanent/part-time job under the Publication House. This skill based certificate course can be a source of income to the students. The course is able to create job opportunity for the students.

Course Period: 30 contact hours inclusive assessment of the participants.

Teaching Method: Discussion with Experiential in a blended mode
